Suggested Strategies to Improve Student Behavior

I. <u>Clear Expectations/Consistent Consequences</u>

- a. Top three behavior expectations posted (and discussed)
 - i. Teacher in Front = Class is quiet
 - 1. Have an "anchor" spot, chair, podium
 - 2. Conduct periodic "Check on Learning"
 - a. As a class
 - b. Random individuals
 - c. Think-Pair-Share

ii. Respectful conversations

- 1. Wait to be called on to speak
- 2. No talking back
- 3. No "play-by-play" needed
- 4. No separate conversations (outside of group work)

iii. No horseplay

- 1. No throwing things in class
- 2. No hitting the walls
- 3. Keep your hands to yourself

b. Name, Check, Circle

- i. Name= first warning- identify behavior if necessary
- ii. **Check**=second warning- no discussion necessary
- iii. Circle=referral to office

*REFUSAL = REMOVAL (give up phone, put away hat, sit in assigned seat, turn off music, etc)

II. Consistent Class Structure

- a. Bell Ringer
 - i. Take attendance
 - ii. Get students busy, settled in, ready for lesson

b. Plan for the day

- i. Lesson/review
- ii. Practice Set (together, as a class)
- iii. Work through first problem on own
 - 1. Check on learning
 - 2. Answer common questions before moving on
- iv. Work time
 - 1. Plan for "I'm done"
 - 2. Address class from "anchor spot" if class gets off topic
- v. Wrap it up
 - 1. Extended lesson
 - 2. Homework/plan for tomorrow
